NORWICH CASTLE MUSEUM, ART GALLERY and COURTROOM

Once a Norman royal palace, then a medieval prison, the Castle was converted in 1894 into a civic museum and, with several galleries created since then, has become a major visitors' attraction housing a fine collection of the Norwich School of Paintings, Norwich silver, Lowestoft porcelain and ceramic teapots, to name but a few of its treasures. An essential East Anglian visit! You may like to bring your seat sticks. Visit is currently limited to a 35-seater coach.
